Akkamahadevi University has been participating in the scheme right from its inception. The NSS Cell in the University is very active in enrolling a large number of UG and PG students. The Cell also directs and coordinates with NSS Units of all the affiliated colleges in implementing various programmes. Our college is having two units which have been established with a rudimentary objective of providing a dais for the interested students to partake in social work during their free time. The units organizes annual and special camps and socially relevant programmes - like Blood donation camps, Health check-up and treatment camps, legal awareness, environment awareness and AIDS awareness Swachchata programs. It also has actively participated in the flood relief programmes. The Government has ordered from the year 2015-16 the NSS unit is compulsory to all Degree Colleges. At present the scheme is run by the ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports in Central & State Government.




Date: 28/03/2019
